Abstract:

The subject of this thesis is exemplified by studying the reality of the security relations between USA and Iraq since 2003 and until 2011. This period witnessed the collapse of the Iraqi political system because of the national military interference led by the USA and UK without the approval of the united nations organization which was obtained later according to the security council decision no. 1438/2003.

Then the Iraqi file was transferred to the united nations organization which constituted multinational forces that worked with its approval and led by USA which became the most influential country in Iraq.

Security Relations Between The United States of America & Iraq and its Political Reflections from 2003–2011 is important for it witnessed great developments on the level of the relations between both parties which had an effect on the Arab arena and even the international one. The relations reached the agreement to withdraw the forces from Iraq in 2008. But this does not mean that the relation remained not affected by some factors like when the USA did not support Iraq against the countries which supported terrorism against Iraq.

It is worth noticing that this subject is one of the modern subjects especially when the relations between the two countries took a new course when it changed from conflict to cooperation.

The problem of the thesis lies in the fact that, in spite of the unequal strategic abilities between the two countries but both parts sought

to build dual relations in the military security aspect based on common basis especially after 2003.

The thesis came in four chapters, the first one discussed thew strategic abilities of the USA. This chapter is divided into two sections, the first is the Iraqi military forces, the second is the American security institutions.

As for the second chapter, it tackled Iraqi strategic abilities in two sections the first is the Iraqi military abilities and the second is the Iraqi security institutions.

In the third chapter the researcher discussed the American invasion of Iraq and it also came in two sections which discussed the motives of the invasion and the consequences of that invasion.

In the fourth chapter the study is dedicated to investigate the Iraqi–American agreement concerning the withdrawal of the military forces from Iraq. It came in two sections that discussed the ability of Iraq to sign such a deal and the withdrawal of the forces with all the sequences of that step.

The adopted method was the analytical method because it is the most appropriate method in relation to the nature of the researched subject.
