carrying the title ((To what extent to The current research legislatively grant the financial privileges to the Iraqi parliament members – comparative study). The main goal of the study is to stan on the fragile points in the legislations that rule the parliament member 's privileges. The current laws, orders study has dealt with and decisions and comparing them with some countries. We have found that the Iraqi parliament member 's privileges have been inserted according to a law and a decision. Generally speaking, the Iraqi legislator has been unsuccessful in the method and quantity of these privileges in comparing with the Iraqi economic situation and in comparing to the Iraqi employees' salary. The reasons lies in non-existing specific procedures to govern these privileges, but rather the Iraqi legislator left free in this aspect, based on his consciousness. This actually contributes into exaggeration and taking the parliament membership as a means for getting money on account of the citizens' rights. This contributes into granting the Iraqi parliament members privileges just as bonus, financial grants , expenses of residence, remedy, fuel and guards. Moreover, the members are also granted pension salary that stand against the general rules of other states. We have found that the countries place impedes and obstacles on the legislator in his privileges. We have also indicated some results and suggestions.
